ESSENTIAL DUTIES / SKILLS / RESPONSIBILITIES

- The ability to trouble shoot / resolve spray issues without assistance
- Must have sprayed at least three of the following barge types with accuracy:
 - Rake hopper barge
 - Hopper barge
 - Sectional barge
 - Deck barge
- Perform all RE's to chart
- Perform the spray functions of external – Gunwale and Coaming with zero (0) defects
- Operate the Solvent Recovery System
- Must be able to label waste
- Must be able to lead a small crew
- Must be able to complete the following logs:
 - Waste log
 - Solvent Recovery log
 - Pressure log
 - Usage Report
- Assist in the control of inventory
- Assist Supervisor

SKILL FACTORS

- Must have proper spraying technique to prevent runs and sags
- Must know how and when to properly mask off areas of the barge not to be painted when necessary
- Must be knowledgeable and use proper personal protective equipment
- Must be trained in confined space entry rules and regulations
- Must be aware of proper testing for oxygen levels and LEL benchmarks before entering confined space to spray paint
- Must be knowledgeable of proper ventilation techniques using air horns and exhaust fans
- Must be knowledgeable of explosion proof requirements of all equipment in the paint building

WORK CONDITIONS

- Environment is that of a heavy industrial worksite.
- Outdoor elements are a factor. Extreme weather conditions such as heat and cold
- Exposure to air particles such as dust and chemicals
- Exposure to loud, penetrating noises in some work areas
- Proper personal protective equipment is required at all times such as, metatarsal boots, ear plugs/ear muffs, safety glasses, long sleeved shirts and pants, hard hats and respirator use
